MANAGEMENT REPORT / OLD BUSINESS: Robin reviewed the Management Report.

Fine and Penalty Policy – The Board reviewed the amended Fine and Penalty policy whereas an automatic \$300 fine will be assessed to any owner who begins an exterior modification, that would otherwise require Architectural Committee approval, without prior written approval.

Motion made by Connie, second by Ed to approve the new Fine Policy as written. The Motion carried.

HOMEOWNER SESSION:

Mr. Torrens talked about the drainage wash on his property that he maintains has had all of the rock wash away. He has had it cleaned up, but there is a concern because his wash takes the brunt of the water coming all the way down from Blue Spruce Circle, which gets dumped from other washes onto his property.
